

Repping Your Vehicles in Simulcast Tutorial

You will have 5 main actions available when repping your vehicle during an auction sale.


ACCEPT – Clicking the Green Accept button will let the auctioneer know that you have accepted the bid offer.

REJECT – Clicking the Red Reject button will let the auctioneer know that you have declined the bid offer.

IF BID – Clicking the Yellow IF Bid button will let the auctioneer know to sell the vehicle as an IF.

COUNTER – You may type in a counter offer amount in the text box. Once you have typed in the amount and click the Yellow Counter button, the counter amount will be notified to the online bidders as well as the Auctioneer. From there they can accept or decline the counter offer amount.

CLERK CHAT – You have the ability to send messages to the Clerk and Auctioneer by typing your message in the text box and clicking the Green Clerk Chat button.
